



### **Tony Hillerman Graduate Fellowship**

Fall 2017- Spring 2018 (20 hours per week)

#### The Fellowship Program

Tony Hillerman Graduate Fellowships are awarded to students enrolled at the University of New Mexico to assist with the development of the Tony Hillerman Portal, a website that enables students and scholars to research Tony Hillerman's original manuscripts and papers online. Tony Hillerman (1925-2008) was an internationally renowned New Mexico writer who published 29 mystery novels and many non-fiction works.

### **Duties and Responsibilities**

Fellows work with original manuscripts and photographs, and create original content for the Tony Hillerman Portal website - specific duties will be assigned based on the Fellow's major areas of study and experience. Fellows also create social media content and participate in presentations and public events about the project.

#### Terms of the Award

The award is for \$15,000 for the 2017-2018 Academic Year. The fellow will work 20 hours per week during each semester.

#### **Fellowship Application Requirements**

Applicants for the Tony Hillerman Graduate Fellowship must meet the following requirements:

- Completed application form and packet (see next page).
- Graduate student in residence at the University of New Mexico with a minimum of 6 credit hours completed.
- Good writing, communication, organization and time management skills.
- Experience using Microsoft Windows and Microsoft Office.
- Experience creating content for online use (websites, social media).
- Legally authorized to work in the United States.
