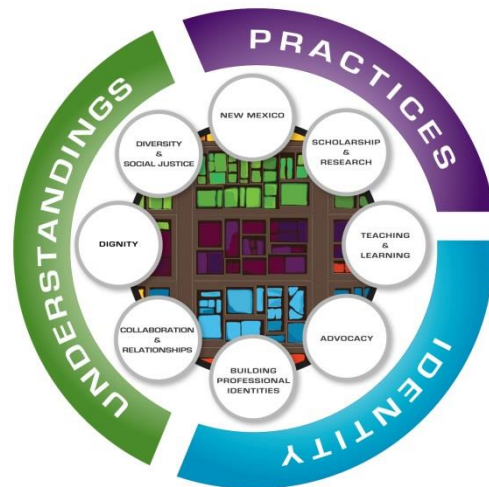
Qualifications:
