Application Deadline: *First Friday in January for Fall*

Application for admissions	Specific instructions
Program of Interest	Select: College of Arts and Sciences > Anthropology > Anthropology 1. List 1-3 faculty in the Department that you wish to work with. 2. Specify "Area" and/or "Topic" of Interest (e.g., SW; Ceramics or Mexico; Women and Health, etc.). 3. Select: Archaeology, or Ethnology, or Evolutionary Archaeology, or Public Archaeology. Do not select "undecided". Can ignore 2nd interest.
Test Scores	GRE required: Anthropology Applicants must take the "General" GRE (not "Subject"). Ignore "subject" on the online application. International Students must also take the TOEFL or equivalent as accepted by UNM International Admissions Office
Letter of Intent	Required. No special instructions.
Writing Sample	Optional. No special instructions.
CV/Resume	Optional. No special instructions.
Assistantship Interest	Optional. Indicate if interested and provide additional information if you wish. See information on Anthropology Admissions web page http://anthropology.unm.edu/programs_graduate_admissions.htm
Important links	Specific instructions
Recommendations	Three (3) letters are required; academic letters strongly suggested.
