APPLICATION CATEGORY	SPECIFIC INSTRUCTIONS
Program of Interest	 Select: College of Arts and Sciences>Anthropology>Anthropology List 1-3 faculty in the Department that you wish to work with. Specify "Area" and/or "Topic" of Interest (e.g., SW; Ceramics or Mexico; Women and Health; etc.) Select: Archaeology, or Ethnology, or Evolutionary Archaeology, or Public Archaeology. Do not select "undecided." Can ignore 2nd interest.
Test Scores	GRE required: Anthropology applicants must take the general GRE (not a subject test). Ignore "subject" on the online application. International students must also take the TOEFL or equivalent as accepted by the UNM Global Education Office.
Letter of Intent	Required. No special instructions.
Writing Sample	Optional. No special instructions.
CV/Resume	Optional. No special instructions.
Assistantship Interest	Optional. Indicate if interested and provide additional information if you wish. See information on the Anthropology Admissions web page: http://anthropology.unm.edu/graduate/admissions.html
Recommendations	Three letters of recommendation are required. Academic letters strongly suggested.
