<b>Program of Interest</b>	Select: College of Arts and Sciences>Anthropology>Anthropology  1. List 1-3 faculty in the Department that you wish to work with. 2. Specify “Area” and/or “Topic” of Interest (e.g., SW; Ceramics or Mexico; Women and Health; etc.) 3. Select: Archaeology, or Ethnology, or Evolutionary Archaeology, or Public Archaeology. Do not select “undecided.” Can ignore 2 <sup>nd</sup> interest.
<b>Test Scores</b>	GRE required: Anthropology applicants must take the general GRE (not a subject test). Ignore “subject” on the online application. International students must also take the TOEFL or equivalent as accepted by the UNM Global Education Office.
<b>Letter of Intent</b>	Required. No special instructions.
<b>Writing Sample</b>	Optional. No special instructions.
<b>CV/Resume</b>	Optional. No special instructions.
<b>Assistantship Interest</b>	Optional. Indicate if interested and provide additional information if you wish. See information on the Anthropology Admissions web page: <a href="http://anthropology.unm.edu/graduate/admissions.html">http://anthropology.unm.edu/graduate/admissions.html</a>
<b>Recommendations</b>	Three letters of recommendation are required. Academic letters strongly suggested.
