



**Application Guidelines for: *Masters of Construction Management (MCM)***

**Application Deadline:**     *To be considered for assistantships: January 31 (international & domestic)*  
*International: March 1 for Fall / August 1 for Spring / January 1 for Summer*  
*Domestic: July 15 for Fall / November 10 for Spring / April 29 for Summer*

Application for admissions	Specific instructions
Educational Background	Applicants without a BS degree in civil engineering, construction engineering, or construction management can be admitted to the program but must demonstrate proficiency in a series of related courses. This series of courses is available on the department website.
Program of Interest	Select: School of Engineering > Civil Engineering > Masters of Construction Management
Test Scores	GMAT or GRE required.
Letter of Intent	The letter of intent should summarize your qualifications and professional goals. Please try to limit to 2 pages.
CV/Resume	Not required for acceptance, but highly recommended.
Relevant Coursework	An undergraduate baccalaureate degree with a minimum GPA of 3.0 (or equivalent) is required for courses in the major field of study over the last two undergraduate years. Enter in this section courses in you major field of study over the last two undergraduate years with course grades.
Video/Audio Link	Not required for acceptance, but may be uploaded if you wish to include in your application file.
Assistantship Interest	To be considered for assistantships, applications should be received by the deadlines indicated above.

Recommendations	Three (3) letters of recommendation are required.
