<b>Letter of Intent</b>	Please give a brief statement regarding your motivation for acquiring an advanced degree, work or research experience, and if any, interest in or contact with an ECE faculty member.
<b>CV/Resume</b>	No special instructions.
<b>Special Requirements</b>	International published papers in peer-reviewed conference proceedings or journals may be uploaded here (optional).
<b>Assistantships</b>	Assistantships are limited and selection process is very competitive. Please submit a short paragraph stating your ability to be self-supporting or financial need, and if any, experience with teaching undergraduate level courses.
<b>Recommendations</b>	Three (3) online letters of recommendation are required. Please enter your recommendation providers right away to help expedite your application.
