Application for admissions	Specific instructions
Program of Interest	Select: College of Education > Individual/Family/Community Education > Counselor Education
Test Scores	GRE or MAT.
Letter of Intent	Letter of Intent indicating those factors in your personal and professional background and experience which have contributed to your pursuing graduate study in Counseling. Mention your short- and long-term goals. Also discuss your experiences with cultural diversity and cultural background. Confine your statement to three (3) double spaced pages. Your application will not be considered complete unless this is submitted.
Writing Sample	A writing sample is required. Sample papers for previous courses taken, or examples of published work, are acceptable.
CV/Resume	Please include: information related to volunteer and professional positions you have had related to the field (including time periods), licenses and certifications held, research and publication experience, memberships and affiliations in professional organizations, any special skills or knowledge, as well as languages spoken/proficiency.
Video/Audio Link	Not required.
Assistantship Interest	Please contact Program Coordinator as soon as possible.
