Application Deadline: *March 1 for Fall & Summer / September 1 for Spring*

Application for admissions	Specific instructions
Program of Interest	Select: College of Education > Language/Literacy/Sociocultural Studies > Educational Linguistics
Test Scores	Not required.
Letter of Intent	A letter of intent clearly describing your background and areas of interest and why you feel the Educational Linguistics Program at the University of New Mexico is well suited to help you meet your goals. Guidelines for writing a letter of intent are provided here: http://grad.unm.edu/resources/gs-forms/letter-of-intent.html
Writing Sample	Required. Submit a copy of the M.A. thesis or a research paper of high quality.
CV/Resume	Required.
Video/Audio Link	Optional.
Important links	Specific instructions
Recommendations	Three (3) letters of recommendation are required. The letters should be from professors or other persons who can comment on your teaching, scholarship, and potential for doctoral study and research.
