



Application Guidelines for: *Educational Psychology (MA, PhD)*

Application Deadline: *March 1 for Summer or Fall / October 1 for Spring*

| Application for admissions | Specific instructions |

| Program of Interest | Select: College of Education > Individual/Family/Community Education > Educational Psychology Identify up to three interest areas. |
| Test Scores | GRE taken within the past 7 years or Miller's Analogy Test (MAT). |
| Letter of Intent | Describe your rationale for pursuing the degree, the congruence between your professional goals and our program and faculty and <u>the names of the faculty with whom you have interviewed</u> . Interviews with a minimum of three faculty members who have primary appointments in the program are required. Interviews will be conducted in person for local applicants and by phone for out of town applicants. <u>The applicant is responsible for making the arrangements for these individual interviews (see the list of program faculty for telephone numbers and e-mail addresses)</u> . International students may conduct interviews with faculty members via email. |
| Writing Sample | For students seeking the Ph.D., attach a sample of written work that provides evidence of your research competence and potential. Examples include a completed master's thesis, a published article or a conference paper. A research proposal or a review of research literature that you have written for a graduate course would also be acceptable. |
| CV/Resume | Optional. |
| Video/Audio link | Optional. |
