Program of Interest	Select: College of Education>Individual/Family/Community Education>Educational Psychology. Identify up to three interest areas.
Test Scores	GRE taken within the past 7 years or Miller's Analogy Test (MAT).
Letter of Intent	Describe your rationale for pursuing the degree and the congruence between your professional goals and our program and faculty.
Writing Sample	For students seeking the Ph.D., attach a sample of written work that provides evidence of your research competence and potential. Examples include a completed master's thesis, a published article or a conference paper. A research proposal or a review of research literature that you have written for a graduate course would also be acceptable.
