



**Application Guidelines for:** *Landscape Architecture (MLA)*

**Application Deadline:** *February 15 for Fall*

Application for admissions	Specific instructions
Educational Background	Applicants must upload unofficial transcripts or their application will be considered incomplete. Official transcripts must also be sent directly to the UNM admissions office.
Program of Interest	Select: School of Architecture and Planning > Landscape Architecture
Letter of Intent	Please outline your interest in the discipline of landscape architecture and the reasons for seeking admission to the program.
CV/Resume	The resume should include education, employment, professional experience, publications, service and other accomplishments.
Special Requirements	All 2 year applicants to the MLA program are required to submit a digital portfolio of your best work. A portfolio is not required for 3 year applicants, but is recommended. You can do this either by uploading a single PDF containing the full set of your images, or by including a link to the website on which your portfolio is located. The portfolio should provide high quality examples of creative thinking and creative approaches. Applicants are encouraged to think about the design and presentation of the portfolio.
Important links	Specific instructions
Recommendations	From three individuals under whom the applicant worked and/or studied. Two of the letters should come from teachers or academic advisors who can comment on the applicant's undergraduate performance.
