Educational Background	Please complete, and include transcripts from each institution attended.
Program of Interest	Select > College of Arts and Sciences > Latin American and Iberian Institute > Latin American Studies
Test Scores	Graduate Record Examination (GRE) scores. Applicants should use the GRE area studies code (2201) listed under departmental codes. If you receive an error message when entering 2201, type in "Area Studies." Students applying to dual degree programs with Law, Business Administration, or Public Health may submit their LSAT, GMAT, or MCAT scores, respectively, in lieu of the GRE. International students must complete the TOEFL exam and submit translated and authenticated transcripts to the Global Education Office .
Letter of Intent	Required. Please see http://lail.unm.edu/info/future-students/graduate-admissions.html for complete instructions.
Writing Sample	A writing sample of approximately 5 - 15 pages in length that demonstrates the applicant's research and analytical abilities, as well as capacity to work across disciplines. It may be written in English, Spanish or Portuguese. Applicants are advised to submit recent work, whether a previously-submitted term paper or an original essay.
CV/Resume	A current CV/resume is required.
