Application Deadline: *February 1 (Fall)*

Application for admissions	Specific instructions
Program of Interest	College of Arts & Sciences > Geography & Environmental Science > Graduate Certificate in Law, Environment, and Geography
Test Scores	Either GRE or LSAT scores from the previous five years
Letter of Intent	A statement of intent outlining your goals in pursuing the certificate, proposed program of studies, and schedule for completion
Writing Sample	A writing sample of no more than five 8.5"-x11" pages that demonstrates your academic and/or professional writing abilities
CV/Resume	A current curriculum vitae
Recommendations	Names and contact information for three people who can speak to your qualifications for the certificate program
Special Requirements	Please include a current academic transcript with your application
Additional Information	<p>All materials should demonstrate (1) serious initial investigation and/or interest in environmental law and/or regulatory issues, (2) strong academic credentials, (3) ability to write cogently, and (4) a clear and compelling set of goals.</p> <p>The director for the graduate certificate in Certificate in Law, Environment, and Geography may waive any of the above requirements if the application as a whole demonstrates that the student has the skills, background, and ability to successfully complete the Certificate.</p>
