



Application Guidelines for: *Master in Public Policy*

Application Deadline: *February 15*

Application for admissions	Specific instructions
Program of Interest	Select: College of Arts and Sciences >Public Policy>Public Policy
Test Scores	GRE General Test required for all applicants. (Institutional code: 4845)
Letter of Intent	Tell us why you want to pursue a degree in public policy, and what work and academic experiences you bring to the program. Also indicate if you plan to study full or part time (this is for planning purposes only and will not impact the admissions decision).
Writing Sample	A writing sample of at least 500 words is required. Topic is not important, as we are looking for your ability to communicate your ideas in writing. Most applicants send a term paper, article or report. Check with us if you have any questions about this requirement. This is also the correct place to upload the previous course work form as a second document.
CV/Resume	Required. No special instructions.
Recommendations	Three letters of recommendation that address your past academic and work performance and aptitude for policy analysis at the graduate level. A mix of academic and work recommenders is encouraged. Ideally, you will have at least one academic letter writer. The online application system will automatically contact your recommenders so that they can confidentially upload the letters.
Relevant Coursework	Do not fill out this section. Please fill out and upload the previous coursework form in addition to your writing sample under "Writing Sample" to indicate fulfillment of this requirement.
