



Application Guidelines for: *Teaching/Learning/Teacher Education (EdD or PhD)*

Application Deadline: *October 30 for Spring/April 30 for Summer or Fall*

Application for admissions	Specific instructions
Program of Interest	Select: College of Education>COE Department of Teacher Education>Teaching, Learning, and Teacher Education Ed.D. or Ph.D
Test Scores	Include a copy of GRE Scores with application materials.
Letter of Intent	Describe why you are applying for this doctoral degree and discuss in detail the goals of your professional future. Describe how a doctoral degree in Teaching, Learning, & Teacher Education will contribute to your learning. Indicate previous degree(s) and professional experience, a thorough description of your teaching or working with children, and describe the community in which you would like to teach.
Writing Sample	Provide a sample of writing that demonstrates your potential as a doctoral student and scholar, and your knowledge of issues related to teaching and learning and teacher education. Please provide a writing sample that demonstrates your current knowledge and/or application of your topic, your skill in organizing your scholarly thoughts and statements, and your skills in writing. Our department uses the Publication Manual of the American Psychological Association (APA).
CV/Resume	Prepare a detailed résumé/curriculum vitae that provides faculty with information about your professional goals, educational achievements, details and dates of teaching experience, and community and extra-curricular experience. We encourage students to seek guidance in producing a well-written résumé/curriculum vitae.
Minimum Requirements	Minimum GPA 3.0; Completion of at least three (3) years of teaching in K-12 settings with a valid teaching license; must have a Master's degree in education or related field.
Special Requirements	Provide a copy of teaching license(s); Click on and complete this Statement of Honesty Form; before applying, set up a meeting with a faculty member in Teacher Education whose interests are similar to your own.
Video/Audio Link	Not required
Assistantship Interest	No special instructions

Relevant Coursework	Minimum requirements: Minimum GPA 3.0; Completion of at least three (3) years of teaching in K-12 settings; must have a Master's degree in education or related field.

Recommendations	3 required. Enter recommenders name and email into system. Once the recommender responds to the email, the form and letter will automatically be uploaded into student's application file.
