

Application Guidelines for: *Urban and Regional Design (CERT)*

Application Deadline: March 1 for Fall / November 1 for Spring

Application for admissions	Specific instructions
Educational Background	Applicants must upload unofficial transcripts or their application will be considered incomplete. Official transcripts must also be sent directly to the UNM admissions office.
Program of Interest	Select: School of Architecture and Planning > Graduate Certificate Programs (SAP) > Urban and Regional Design
Letter of Intent	A letter outlining your goals in pursuing the certificate.
Writing Sample	Samples of written work, include no more than 10 8.5x11 pages.
CV/Resume	The resume should include education, employment, professional experience, publications, service and other accomplishments.
Special Requirements	 A proposed program of study that indicates the courses you will take and a schedule for completion. A brief portfolio of design and planning work. Include no more than 10 8.5x11 pages.
Important links	Specific instructions
Recommendations	Names and contact information of two (2) people who can speak to your qualifications for the certificate.
