AGREEMENT TO MEDIATE

My signature at the bottom of this page verifies that I understand the following statements and that I agree with them.

- 1. Mediation is a process designed to promote communication and problem solving. The process is private and confidential.
- 2. Each party acknowledges that participation in the mediation is voluntary.
- 3. Each party agrees to act in "good faith" to resolve conflict.
- 4. The mediators do not tell the parties what to do. The parties decide how they will resolve their conflict through the mediation process.
- 5. The mediators are neutral third parties. Their role is to facilitate the process by clarification of the issues and concerns, by generating different options, and by assisting with finding a viable solution to the conflict.
- 6. The mediators do not provide legal services or legal advice.
- 7. The parties agree that the mediators should not be called as witnesses in case of future conflicts or judicial proceedings.
- 8. Participation to mediation does not rule out the use of other methods of resolving the dispute.
- 9. The parties understand that the Ombudsperson for graduate students will make a follow-up call to each party for the purpose of checking the status of the agreement or the ongoing process.
