<b>Educational Background</b>	The Master of Accounting program offers tracks for students with an accounting degree from an AACSB accredited institution. For applicants with no accounting degree, the Professional Track is available.
<b>Test Scores</b>	Due to COVID-19, applicants may temporarily apply without an entrance exam. Normally, applicants must have a GMAT/GRE score of 500 or better OR receive a GMAT/GRE waiver. <b>Letter of Intent</b>	Required. No special instructions.
<b>CV/Resume</b>	Required. No special instructions.
<b>Relevant Coursework</b>	MAcc Professional track applicants will need to show grades of B or higher in MGMT 502/ACCT 2110 and MGMT 503/ACCT 2120 before admission semester or will need to fulfill this requirement during the first semester of the program.
<b>Assistantship Interest</b>	Required. No special instructions.
