APPLICATION CATEGORY	SPECIFIC INSTRUCTIONS
Educational Background	<p>Students with an engineering degree in another field may be admitted directly to the program, provided they satisfy all other admissions criteria. However, they may need to take some undergraduate courses that are prerequisites for graduate courses in their field of study. This course sequence must be determined on an individual basis and will depend on the student's background and intended program of study. The preparatory course sequence will be selected in consultation with the CE faculty in the student's intended area of study.</p> <p>Students without an undergraduate engineering degree can be admitted to the program but must take a sequence of undergraduate classes with a cumulative GPA of 3.0 and no grade below a "C." This sequence of classes is available on the department website.</p>
Program of Interest	Select: School of Engineering>Civil, Construction and Environmental>Civil, Construction and Environmental
Test Scores	GRE required. MEng degree accepts passage of the FE exam in lieu of GRE.
Letter of Intent	The letter of intent should summarize your qualifications and professional goals, and indicate the area of civil engineering which you want to pursue. Please try to limit to 2 pages.
CV/Resume	Not required for acceptance, but highly recommended.
Relevant Coursework	A minimum GPA of 3.0 (or equivalent) is required over the last two undergraduate years in science, math, and engineering courses. Enter in this section all science, math, and engineering courses taken over last two undergraduate years with course grades.
Video/Audio Link	Not required for acceptance, but may be uploaded if you wish to include in your application file.
Assistantship Interest	To be considered for assistantships, applications should be received by the deadlines indicated above.
Recommendations	Three (3) letters of recommendation are required.
