Educational Background	One unofficial transcript from every college that you have attended (exception: UNM transcripts). Undergraduate GPA of 3.0 or better. The University requires Official Transcripts for Admission.
Letter of Intent	A letter of intent clearly expressing your ability to undertake graduate study
Writing Sample	One full length (60-120 Page) Stage Play
Recommendations	Three letters of recommendation are required
CV/Resume	Required
