<b>Program of Interest</b>	Select: College of Education>Individual/Family/Community Education>Educational Psychology. Identify up to three interest areas.
<b>Test Scores</b>	For students seeking the PhD, GRE scores taken within the past 7 years or Miller's Analogy Test (MAT) are requested. For students seeking the MA, GRE scores are optional.
<b>Letter of Intent</b>	Describe your rationale for pursuing the degree and the congruence between your professional goals and our program and faculty.
<b>Writing Sample</b>	For students seeking the Ph.D., attach a sample of written work that provides evidence of your research competence and potential. Examples include a completed master's thesis, a published article or a conference paper. A research proposal or a review of research literature that you have written for a graduate course would also be acceptable.
<b>CV/Resume</b>	Optional
<b>Video/Audio Link</b>	Optional
<b>Recommendations</b>	Three online letters of recommendation are required. Please enter your recommendation providers right away to help expedite your application.
