| APPLICATION CATEGORY          | SPECIFIC INSTRUCTIONS   |

| <b>Educational Background</b> | Required BS, BA, or equivalent 4-year degree from an accredited US institution or a recognized foreign institution. Applicants are required to have an overall 3.0 GPA that is based on a 4.0 scale.  |
| <b>Program of Interest</b>    | Select > College of Pharmacy > Pharmaceutical Sciences > Pharmaceutical Sciences > PhD Pharmaceutical Sciences.   |
| <b>Test Scores</b>            | GRE is required; you will need a combined score of 300.   |
| <b>Letter of Intent</b>       | Letter of intent is required. Please include your intended degree, areas of research interest, previous laboratory experience (if any—not required but highly desirable).   |
| <b>CV/Resume</b>              | Required. Include academic and/or scientific awards and publications.   |
| <b>Recommendations</b>        | A minimum of 2 letters of recommendations are required. Your references should be either recent research mentors or faculty members at institutions of higher learning. They should be able to comment on your current ability to perform academically at the graduate level and/or comment on your recent research experience. |
| <b>Special Requirements</b>   | English Proficiency (international students only) one of the below: <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Official TOEFL scores: Minimum 92 iBT</li><li>• Official IELTS scores: Minimum score of 7 IELTS Academic</li></ul>  |
