<b>Educational Background</b>	Unofficial transcripts must be uploaded to the online application. They must include final grades for the fall semester immediately prior to the February 1 <sup>st</sup> deadline (if applicable). Official transcripts must be sent to the UNM Office of Admissions.
<b>Program of Interest</b>	Select: College of Arts and Sciences > Speech and Hearing Sciences > Speech/Language Pathology > MS Speech/Language Pathology
<b>Test Scores</b>	No test scores required.

<b>Relevant Coursework</b>	Applicants must complete a minimum of 12 hours of SHS coursework prior to application. If you have repeated courses we replace up to 12 credits with the higher grade. <b>Assistantship Interest</b>	To be considered for ANY form of departmental financial aid, applicants must complete and upload the SHS department’s financial aid form and complete a FAFSA. <b>Recommendations</b>	Two letters of recommendation are required, all of which must be submitted through the online application system. At least one recommender must be a professor or clinical faculty member from a speech and hearing sciences or communication sciences disorders department. One other recommender MUST be either a professor or a clinical faculty member from any department OR a supervisor/mentor from SLP or a related field who can evaluate your clinical potential.
